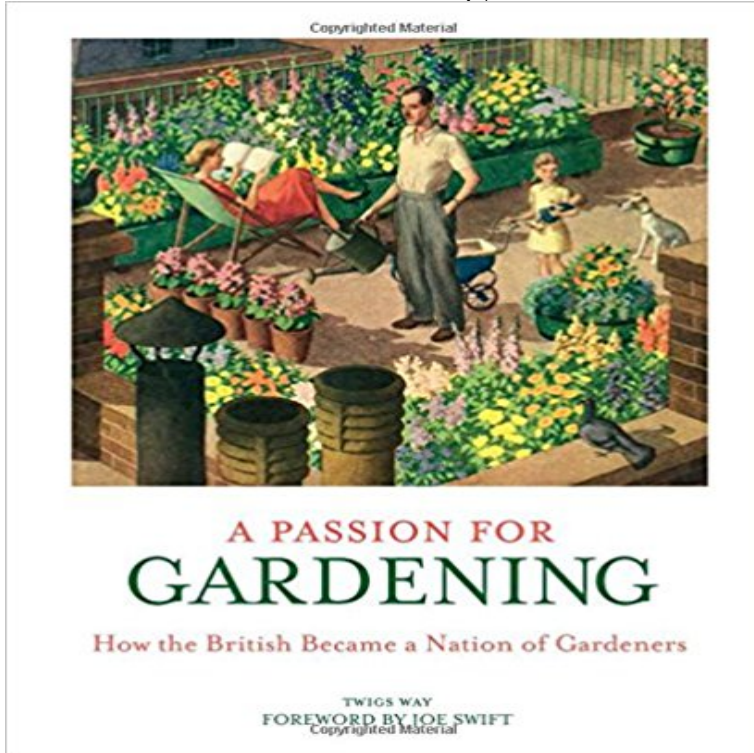


A Passion for Gardening: How the British Became a Nation of Gardeners
